**Father Joseph Ponessa, S.S.D.**, a pastor in Montana, studied Sacred Scripture at the Pontifical University of Biblical Studies (the Biblicum) in Rome, where he learned thirteen languages including Aramaic, the language that Jesus spoke. **Laurie Watson Manhardt, Ph.D.** studied education at the University of Michigan. She and her husband Jim host a Bible study for couples in inter-faith marriages in their home in Florida.
